 - b. House Kitchen and Herb Garden
 - c. Seasonal needs such as snow and leaf removal
5. Work with Education Director to integrate historic education program with agricultural educational program.
6. Develop programs to explore sustainability, urban ecology of present day Brooklyn and its Colonial farms.
