HOW TO FIND US-

BY CAR-

From Grand Central Parkway-

Exit at Francis Lewis Boulevard (Northbound Exit). Take Francis Lewis to Union Turnpike and make a left. Make your second left into the parking lot at 196th Place.

From Long Island Expressway-

Exit at Francis Lewis Boulevard. Go south on Francis Lewis (make right from eastbound exit or left from westbound exit). Go to Union Turnpike and make a right. Make your second left into the parking lot at 196th Place.

****IF PARKING LOT ON 196TH
PLACE & UNION TURNPIKE IS
FULL-****

Make a right turn at lot exit back onto Union Turnpike. Make right turn onto Francis Lewis Boulevard, then make the next right turn back into the back of the park. Follow the park road to the top of the hill and look for parking lot on your right side.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION-

Q46 BUS-

Bus runs east to west along Union Turnpike. Stops in front of park at 196th Place and Union.

Q76 BUS-

Bus runs north to south along Francis Lewis Boulevard. Stops at corner of Union Turnpike & Francis Lewis Boulevard. Walk 3 blocks west along Union Tpke. to entrance at 196th Place.

Q17 & Q75 BUS-

Bus runs north to south along 188th Street. Stops at corner of 188th Street & Union Turnpike. Transfer to Q46 eastbound or walk 5 short blocks to park entrance at 193rd Street & Union Turnpike.

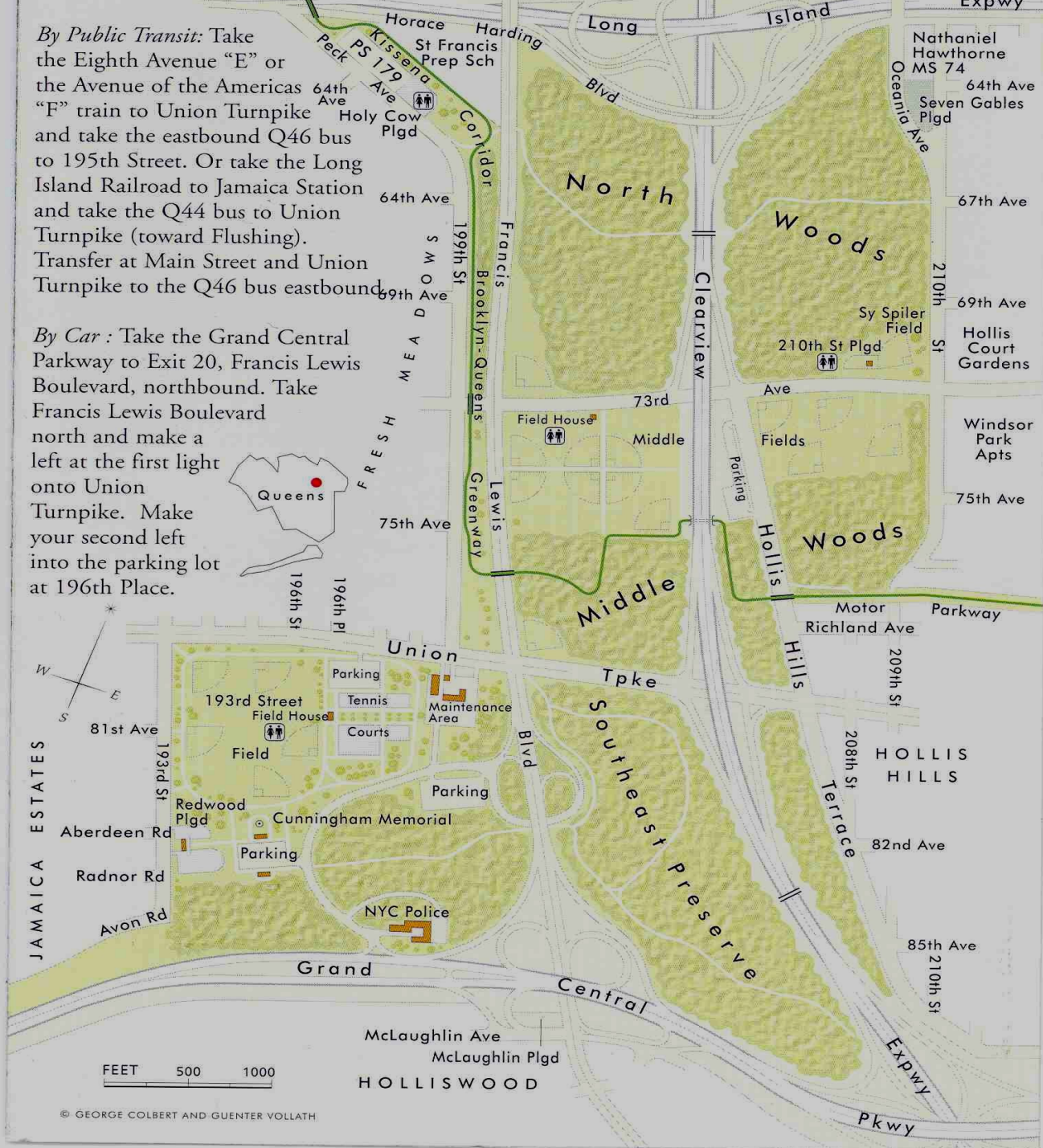

Cunningham Park

By Public Transit: Take the Eighth Avenue "E" or the Avenue of the Americas "F" train to Union Turnpike and take the eastbound Q46 bus to 195th Street. Or take the Long Island Railroad to Jamaica Station and take the Q44 bus to Union Turnpike (toward Flushing). Transfer at Main Street and Union Turnpike to the Q46 bus eastbound.

By Car: Take the Grand Central Parkway to Exit 20, Francis Lewis Boulevard, northbound. Take Francis Lewis Boulevard north and make a left at the first light onto Union Turnpike. Make your second left into the parking lot at 196th Place.
