- Develop drawings, specifications and estimates of quantities for mechanical engineering projects of varied sizes and complexities. Perform design calculations for HVAC, Plumbing, Boilers and related systems.
- Prepare detailed reports on the progress and budget schedules of related projects.
- Coordinate project-specific interagency work, such as permits, filings and approvals. Prepare permit applications for seal and signature of Chief Engineer/Director of Engineering; submit to involved agencies.
- When necessary, manage and review consultant design contracts.
- Present projects for approvals internally and externally with other agencies; provide information and solutions to problems.
- Conduct field inspections before and during design and construction, through turnover.
- Supply Capital designers with engineering component details as requested.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A valid New York State Professional Engineer's License and four years of full-time experience in mechanical engineering. A master's degree in mechanical engineering from an accredited college will be accepted as equivalent to one year of the full-time experience in mechanical engineering.
