This Notice shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of New York.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

The New York City Office of Management and Budget (NYCOMB) is the Responsible Entity (RE) for environmental reviews conducted under the CDBG-DR Program. On or about February 17, 2014, the City will submit a request to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of CDBG-DR funds authorized by the “Disaster Relief Appropriations Act, 2013” (Public Law 113-2) to undertake the reconstruction of the Rockaway Beach Boardwalk and related improvements in the borough of Queens, New York City. In October 2012, Hurricane Sandy damaged most of the approximately 4.7-mile length of the Rockaway Boardwalk. The New York City Department of Parks and Recreation would reconstruct the boardwalk between Beach 20th and Beach 126th Streets, would provide structured access to the beach between Beach 126th and Beach 149th Streets over new dunes currently being constructed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and would restore and enhance existing dunes between Beach 9th and Beach 20th Streets, including constructing at-grade access through the dunes.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The City has determined that the proposed project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) and Environmental Assessment (EA) on file with Mr. Calvin Johnson, Assistant Director, New York City Office of Management and Budget, 255 Greenwich Street, 7th Floor, New York, NY 10007, (212) 788-6024 and may be examined or copied weekdays 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments to NYCOMB at the address listed above. All comments received before February 16, 2014 will be considered by OMB prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Those wishing to comment should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

NYCOMB certifies to HUD that Dean Fuleihan in his capacity as Certifying Officer of the CDBG-DR Program consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its

responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows OMB to use CDBG-DR funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will consider objections to its release of funds and the NYCOMB's certification for a period of fifteen days following its actual receipt of the request only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of OMB; (b) OMB has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to: Tennille Parker, Disaster Recovery and Special Issues Division, Office of Block Grant Assistant, HUD, 451 7th Street SW, Rm. 7272, Washington, DC 20410. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.

El Departamento de Parques y Recreación de la ciudad de Nueva York reconstruirá el Malecón entre las calles Beach 20 y Beach 126, que proporcionaría acceso estructurado a la playa entre las calles Beach 126 y Beach 149 sobre las dunas nuevas actualmente en construcción por el Cuerpo de Ingenieros del Army de los Estados Unidos y restauraría y mejoraría las dunas existentes entre las calles Beach 9 y Beach 20, incluyendo construcción de acceso a nivel de la playa a través de las dunas.

The New York City Department of Parks and Recreation would reconstruct the boardwalk between Beach 20th and Beach 126th Streets, would provide structured access to the beach between Beach 126th and Beach 149th Streets over new dunes currently being constructed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and would restore and enhance existing dunes between Beach 9th and Beach 20th Streets, including constructing at-grade access through the dunes.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

NYCOMB certifies to HUD that Dean Fuleihan in his capacity as Certifying Officer of the CDBG-DR Program consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows OMB to use CDBG-DR funds.



СТРАХОВКА ДОРОЖАЕТ**
Наличие корпоративного медицинского плана — вещь хорошая и полезная, однако за нее, увы, приходится все больше платить.

Как показал опрос, проведенный Bankrate.com, всего за год 47% работающих отметили, что отчисления из их зарплаты на ежемесячные взносы увеличились. А еще 44% сообщили об увеличении доли, погашаемой самим застрахован-

ным, и росте других выплат, которые в случае болезни приходится осуществлять из собственного кармана.



Nursery school is sued in sex-abuse case

Big Bird Playhouse and its principal are named in suits alleging counselor molested 2 young girls

ST. GEORGE — Summer camp at Big Bird's Playhouse in Bulls Head was supposed to be fun-filled with outings and trips to the movies.

But two young girls contend their experience was a nightmare — and have sued the camp, alleging a counselor molested them, according to two lawsuits.

Court papers allege that Endrick Torres, 33, abused one girl eight different times in the summer of 2012. The other youngster maintains he molested her on Aug. 20 of last year, said court documents.

Torres, who had worked at the camp for four years, was arrested in August and charged in two separate cases with multiple counts of sexual abuse and forcible touching, according to Advance reports and online state court records.

Those cases are pending in Stapleton Criminal Court, and Torres is free on a total of \$50,000 bail, records show. The civil suits allege the victims suffered physical, mental and sexual abuse and are injured and scarred for life.

Filed in state Supreme Court, St. George, the lawsuits seek unspecified monetary damages and name Big Birds Playhouse Corp. and its principal, Linda Indelicate, as defendants.

Ms. Indelicate declined comment on the lawsuits when reached by telephone.

The plaintiffs' attorney, Paul A. Fino Jr., of Manhattan, did not respond to phone messages seeking comment.

NAMES WITHHELD

According to its website, Big Birds Playhouse has been in business since 1991 and provides a "safe environment where children feel love, respected and safe."

The center's name is listed as "Big Bird Play House" on its website and as "Big Birds Playhouse Corp." on online New York Department of State records.

The plaintiffs' names are being withheld.

The civil suits allege one girl was molested eight times in the summer of 2012.

According to Advance reports, prosecutors said a camper was abused over an eight-week period, between July 1 and Aug. 31, 2012. The alleged victim was 8 and then 9 years old.

A law enforcement source familiar with the case said

the camp met weekly, and the abuse happened each time the girl attended over the summer, eight times in total, both on a camp bus and at a movie theater.

The youngster tended to get cold in the movie theater, the source said, and would bring either a blanket or a towel to cover her legs to keep warm. Torres, an Elmhurst, Queens resident, would tell the girl that he was cold as well, then put his hands under the blanket or towel, and molest her, the source alleged.

The child told her mother she didn't want to return to camp the next year, but wouldn't say why at first, the source said. However, she confided in her older sister, said the source.

The girl's mother asked her about Torres, after the Advance and other media outlets reported his arrest last summer stemming from allegations of an unrelated molestation incident on Aug. 13.

The youngster became upset and ultimately told the story, the source said.

The Aug. 13 episode occurred as campers traveled to a roller rink in New Jersey after a trip to the movies, according to a law enforcement source.

Traffic on the West Shore Expressway forced camp officials to head to Bloomingdale Park instead, though, and their bus got lost and ultimately wound up going to another Staten Island park after nearly two hours, the source said.

A 10-year-old girl was sitting in a rear seat with her best friend when Torres, known as "Mr. E" to the campers, told her friend to move one seat over, the source said.

Torres then told the 10-year-old girl to "open your legs," and when she asked "Why?" he responded that "it will feel good," the law enforcement source said.

He then molested her, and she mouthed "help me" to her best friend, but the friend responded, "With what?" the source said.

The girl told her mother about what Torres had done and the suspect was arrested the next day, according to the law enforcement source.

It was not immediately clear whether the date of the Aug. 20 incident alleged in the civil filings is inaccurate and it is actually the same as the Aug. 13 episode disclosed by authorities, or whether it involves a separate camper. Civil filings say the Aug. 20 incident occurred on one of the camp's "trips/excursions/activities/travels," but provide no further details.

Torres' criminal defense lawyer, John M. Murphy Jr., declined comment on the lawsuits.

City agrees to monitor of NYPD

De Blasio also announces that the appeal of a federal judge's stop-and-frisk ruling would be dropped

BROOKLYN — The city will agree to a federal NYPD monitor and will drop its appeal of a judge's finding that the NYPD had unconstitutionally used its stop-and-frisk crime-fighting technique, Mayor Bill de Blasio announced Thursday.

"This has been a long road and this is a moment, I think, of profound progress," de Blasio said at a recreation center in the Brownsville neighborhood of Brooklyn.

The appeal of Judge Shira A. Scheindlin's ruling had been filed by former Mayor Michael Bloomberg — but de Blasio has long pledged to reform stop-and-frisk and drop the appeal.

Stop-and-frisk was a major campaign issue in the mayor's race. Members of minority groups have said they are unfairly targeted by the technique, as the vast majority of stops happen to young black and Latino men — and the vast majority of those stopped are innocent.

Some in the city, including Staten Island Republicans, have argued reforms like a federal monitor will make it difficult for police to do their job of keeping crime at historic lows.

BRATTON'S VIEW

But de Blasio said the city could be safe without the violation of civil rights. And Police Commissioner William Bratton has said he believes stop-and-frisk is an effective law enforcement tool — but when used unfairly, can be the opposite.

"Instead of securing confidence, instead of securing legitimacy and procedural justice in this city for the residents, it instead has raised doubts and concerns about the police force in this city," Bratton said.

As part of the agreement in the class action Floyd vs. the City of New York case, the city will agree to a federal monitor of the NYPD for three years. That's in addition to an inspector general overseeing the police force, as part of the Community Safety Act passed last year,

which will be permanent.

The city will also participate in outreach with communities on how to better relations.

"As soon as the federal court ratifies this agreement, we will drop the appeal and also with the court's approval we will settle the case," de Blasio said.

City Councilman Steven Matteo (R-Mid-Island/Brooklyn) said he doesn't believe an independent monitor is necessary and that he deems stop-and-frisk a valuable tool.

"I believe the NYPD already has enough oversight — after the mayor's office, district attorneys, internal affairs," Matteo said. "I don't want the NYPD to be handcuffed. Their job is to use every effective and legal tool."

Councilwoman Debi Rose (D-North Shore), who voted in favor of the Community Safety Act that will establish the NYPD inspector general, disagreed.

"The debate over police policies is not about micro-managing the police who are called upon to make life-and-death, split-second decisions," Ms. Rose said. "It is about legitimate oversight and making our city safer through more effective use of the police in fighting crime."

Ms. Rose said she believes the increase in stop-and-frisk is due to productivity goals set for police.

"In fact, I have spoken with numerous officers who themselves are uncomfortable with this policy and the punitive actions that result if they don't meet the productivity goals," Ms. Rose said.

Borough President James Oddo was the only borough president who didn't praise de Blasio's decision in a press release. Oddo voted against the Community Safety Act and said he agreed with Bloomberg's decision to appeal the court's finding that the NYPD needed an inde-

pendent monitor.

"That said, I trust that the de Blasio administration has consulted with Commissioner Bratton and that this agreement has been sort of vetted through his prism, and there's nothing in it that will constrain his ability to run a department to keep us safe," Oddo said. "That's what I'm holding on to."

FABRIC OF CITY

Bratton said police could enforce the law without breaking the law. Police and the people they serve are each one thread of the fabric of a city, he said, and the more tightly sewn, the better.

"In New York, because of this issue, that fabric has been torn," he said. "We need

to mend it. We need to repair it."

While it was a victory for advocates of reforming the practice, some were cautious in their comments.

"Nobody standing here is pretending this is mission accomplished. The problem has not been solved," said Vincent Warren, executive director of the Center for Constitutional Rights. "The reality is tomorrow a kid may be humiliated on his way home from school. Or someone on their way to the store might get stopped and frisked for no reason."
