The Greenbelt Native Plant Center is a 10-acre greenhouse and nursery complex owned by the City of New York Department of Parks & Recreation.

The Nursery's mission is to provide locally-derived native plants for city-sponsored natural area restoration and management projects. the Nursery also provides plants for smaller-scaled community-based efforts in the five boroughs.

Our goal is to insure short-term establishment and long-term ecological integration of natural area projects, providing the greatest measure of protection and enhancement for New York City's biodiversity.

Towards this goal, we research appropriate populations for seed.. Collect seeds conservatively so as to maintain extant populations; and record the provenance of each plant grown at the Nursery with the aid of a custom-designed Inventory Tracking System database. this allows us to track our plants from seed source to project destination.

The Greenbelt Native Plant Center now operates a regional, active seed bank. This facility allows us to store, seed of local provenance for future restoration projects. Banking of seed for your projects can be discussed with the Nursery Director





Early notification of orders for large-scale restoration projects is critical. The most successful restorations involve the Nursery in their planning stage. Plant specifications provided soon after the design is first developed gives the Nursery time to custom collect seeds and use our resources to grow specifically for a project. Early involvement also takes advantage of the Nursery's advisory services.

The Nursery has the ability to generate fully refined habitat-specific plant lists, for large-scale restoration projects throughout the region.

We also have generalized plant lists for common habitat types available to projects of small scope, and it is possible to purchase plants for smaller projects on short notice as we have many species on hand ready for purchase.

Note on bulk seed: The Greenbelt Native Plant Center has initiated a new program to develop bulk seed products. This is a long-term effort that will take *4-5 years to yield seed products*. We welcome your inquiries about future projects you maybe developing.

Directions to Nursery

From Verrazano Bridge:

Proceed west on Staten Island Expressway (I-278) to West Shore Expressway (South 440) Exit. Take South 440 to Exit 7: Victory Blvd. At the first traffic light turn left onto Victory Blvd and proceed 0.7 miles to the Greenbelt Native Plant Center located on the right at 3808 Victory Blvd.

From Bayonne Bridge:

Proceed south on 440: Dr. Martin Luther King Expressway to the West I-278/South 440 Exit. Take south 440 to Exit 7: Victory Blvd. At the first traffic light turn left onto Victory Blvd and proceed 0.7 miles to the Greenbelt Native Plant Center located on the right at 3808 Victory Blvd.

From Goethals Bridge:

Immediately move to the right hand lane of the Staten Island Expressway (I-278) upon exiting toll plaza. Exit onto the West Shore Expressway (South 440). Take South 440 to Exit 7: Victory Blvd. At the first traffic light turn left onto Victory Blvd and proceed 0.7 miles to the Greenbelt Native Plant Center located on the right at 3808 Victory Blvd.

From Outerbridge:

Proceed along Richmond Parkway to Exit 2: West Shore Expressway (North 440). Take North 440 to Exit 7: Victory Blvd. At the first traffic light turn right onto Victory Blvd and proceed 0.6 mile to the Greenbelt Native Plant Center on the right at 3808 Victory Blvd.
