NYC Parks is the steward of nearly 30,000 acres of land — 14 percent of New York City — including more than 5,000 individual properties ranging from Coney Island Beach and Central Park to community gardens and Greenstreets. We operate more than 800 athletic fields and nearly 1,000 playgrounds, 1,800 basketball courts, 550 tennis courts, 67 public pools, 51 recreational facilities, 15 nature centers, 14 golf courses, and 14 miles of beaches. We care for 1,200 monuments and 23 historic house museums. We look after 600,000 street trees, and two million more in parks. We are New York City's principal providers of recreational and athletic facilities and programs. We are home to free concerts, world-class sports events, and cultural festivals.

Under NYC Parks' Communications office, the Digital Media division develops the official Parks website, partner websites, and email newsletter system. In addition, the division is responsible for designing and building custom web applications for high-profile public-facing Mayoral, City Council, and Agency projects. The Digital Media Web Developer will join a small agile team of developers, designers, and content producers to support the creation of compelling and dynamic web experiences for over 8 million visitors to the Parks website each year, as well as critical content management systems used on a daily basis by staff and partners.

### MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Under direct supervision, with latitude for independent initiative and judgment, design and build front-end web applications, and related software functions.
- Architect and develop scalable, responsive front-end systems using HTML5, CSS3, JavaScript, jQuery, and front-end libraries.
- Leverage API services and data feeds to build dynamic large scale web applications.
- Maintain and enhance existing custom applications and content management systems built in-house.
- Analyze and research solutions to improve efficiency, scalability, and stability of various systems and components.
- Collaborate with an agile team of developers, designers, and project managers throughout system development, and iteratively improve and refine applications.

### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of experience in community work or community centered activities in an area related to the duties described above; or
2. High school graduation or equivalent and six years of experience in community work or community centered activities in an area related to the duties as described above; or
3. Education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least one year of experience as described in "1" above.

### PREFERRED SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS

1. Solid visual and user experience design skills, along with deep understanding of web standards and accessibility.
2. Enthusiastic problem-solver, enjoys new challenges, and takes ownership of project work.
3. Ability to work independently and handle multiple projects simultaneously in a fast-paced deadline-driven environment.
4. Experience collaborating within a team using task management (JIRA), and version control systems (Git).
5. Familiarity in geo-spatial web mapping using Google Maps APIs, Leaflet, Mapbox, ESRI, etc.

Residency in New York City, Nassau, Orange, Rockland, Suffolk, Putnam or Westchester counties required for employees with over two years of city service. New York City residency required for all other candidates.
