

Fort Washington Park

- Improve active and passive recreation areas
- Improve park access from the community
- Improve and connect the north-south bikeway
- Restore the health of the forest and ecologies
- Improve shoreline access

Fort Tryon Park

- Continue restoration of historic Olmsted Brothers' landscape in accordance with existing master plan
- Expand uses of playground areas
- Increase management of invasive trees for forest health and views
- Restore historic structures and use them

Inwood Hill and Isham Parks

- Restore natural water ecologies and systems
- Control invasive plants
- Open important views
- Focus on natural character
- Develop a comprehensive trail marking system to increase park use and safety
- Improve vehicular access of pathways for police and M&O
